## How to Whitelist PSM email addresses

Whitelisting a domain or specific email address will ensure that those **emails reach your inbox**. You will need to add PSM's domain to a list call 'SAFE SENDERS', which will ensure our emails will be pushed to your inbox, regardless of your spam filters.

Instructions may be slightly different depending on your email provider.

## Option 1:

- 1. Right click on any email from PSM (ends with @psmportraits.com)
- 2. Choose Junk > Never Block Sender's Domain (@example.com)
- 3. The sender's domain @psmportraits.com will be added to your Safe Senders List

## Option 2 (using Outlook as an example):

- 1. Click on "Settings", then "View all Outlook settings"
- 2. Go to "Junk email", then choose "Safe senders and domains" or "Safe mailing lists" to select the domain or email you want to whitelist
- 3. Choose ADD and enter the domain name @psmportraits.com (your must include the @)
- \*Alternatively, you can simply add an individual email address to your Outlook Contacts
